- Length of time acquainted with applicant
- Applicant's strengths and weaknesses
- Applicant's goals
- Examples which elaborate on the applicant's commitment to the Latino community

2) Personal Narrative

In a written statement of at least 200 words, please describe the following:

- Goals and ambitions
- Commitment to the Latino community
- Reasons for pursuing a degree in the field that you have chosen
- Plan to contribute to the Latino community when you graduate

3) Official High School Transcripts

4) SAT/ACT Score Report (optional)

5) Copy of both parents' or guardians' 201_ Tax Return

6) Applicants born outside of the United States, please provide a copy of their birth certificate or other documents verifying their country of birth.

General Information

All scholarship applicants must adhere to the following requirements:

- All applicants must be graduates of a high school (or GED program) located in Illinois.
- All applicants must have a minimum high school Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.75 (on a 4.0 scale)
- All applicants must be accepted or enrolled in a baccalaureate degree granting college or university located in the U.S. or Puerto Rico.
- All applicants must be registered (or plan to be registered) as full-time students.

Applicants must be available to be interviewed by the selection committee.
